'Free play' expertise

Free play sparks new interests and builds a child's confidence in their own skills. At Allsorts we offer FUNtastic free play sessions in our natural play area. When children take control of their play they develop their natural curiosity through experimentation and problem-solving using the material around them.

Allsorts has been selected as one of only 27 organisations in Scotland to be supported by Inspiring Scotland's Go Play scheme (see www.inspiringscotland.org.uk) to develop free play and to evaluate the benefits to children of regular child-driven and mainly outdoor play.



Where is Allsorts?

After-school club

Base camp is the canteen of Dornoch Academy with weekly FUNtastic sessions in the Allsorts natural play area of the school garden.

Opening hours: Monday - Friday, 2:30pm to 6:30pm (on school in-service days and during the October and Easter holidays we open at 8.30am)

Holiday club

In summer we're in the centre of town at the West Church Hall. This makes it easier to go to the beach and the woods and allows us to take part in local events. The hall has its own enclosed garden for outdoor play and the space and facilities for arts, crafts and baking. Children regularly visit our natural play area at the school to tend the vegetable garden, climb trees and build and play in the shelters.

Opening hours: Monday - Friday, 8.30am to 6.30pm
